Civil War Living History May 20 - 22.

Dick M. checked with fire chief Jim Gould. We can park behind the station or at the side, but not block doors; also park on one side of road only. We'll need signs! Vendors must set up 21' from the center line, no permit needed. If there's a no-burn alert they can't have campfires. Dick M. will check with him again right before set up.

Susy Sanders offered her two canopies (@20X12). Larry suggested asking Janet White for the Chamber tent or Steve Smith. Dick S. has a 10X10 gazebo to use.

Tables & chairs can be borrowed from P.A.C.C. – in fact, Todd Olsen offered some tables to P.A.C.C. from the church – possibly get them for this?

Larry will get large drums for trash.

Pam reports GrantLee's restaurant will set up tent with smoked pulled pork sandwiches, cole slaw, & baked beans with a drink.

Pam has spoken with Micah Frye, a spinner from Avon, about a group of spinners, weavers, and quilters setting up under a tent to demonstrate/sell their crafts, possibly in period costume. This is not sure yet.

No entrance fee, no vendor fee. Revitalization needs a way to make money. (We need to pay for a port-a-potty.) Dick M. will ask GrantLee's if we can sell the drinks. Also, he'll ask Camden Bank if we can borrow their popcorn machine. We might also sell a dessert – Pam suggests ice cream if we can keep it cold enough.

The 15th Alabama will return during Old Home Days. Okay from Janet White given, and SR & RL RR is on board.

“Starting a Business Day”. Margaret has contacted Sylvia Lambert for help. Possibly scheduled for this Fall.

For the **Rail Fair on October 8**, the P.A.C.C. has agreed to let us use the Community Center, but no decision yet on rental fee. We would like to keep it with no entrance fee this year, but would ask a nominal fee of the vendors. Dick M. will talk to Matt Sharp about this. Larry will ask the P.A.C.C. if they'd care to sell light breakfast foods in the morning; and Dick S. will ask the Legion if they'd sell a lunch in the depot that day. We will consider a supper when plans are firmed up with Bill Berry and his plans for the bluegrass band.
